**Re: AIM Specialty Health Clinical Guidelines update – Sleep Disorder Management**

Anthem Blue Cross and Blue Shield and our subsidiary company, HMO Colorado (Anthem), is writing to inform you of the following updates to the AIM Specialty Health® (AIM) Clinical Guidelines. AIM is a separate company.

Effective for dates of service on and after January 28, 2019, CPT code A7047 (oral interface used with respiratory suction pump) will be removed from the AIM clinical guidelines for Sleep Disorder Management and will no longer apply.
